Edgar Allan Poe (1809-1849)



Edgar Allan Poe's life

- his parents were actors, both died when he was two years old
- addopted by a rich Allan family good relationship with his step mother but not with his step father – very strict to him
- he got good education X problems at university in Charlotesville – bad behaviour, hazardous games, debts, drinking sent down

- his step father sent him to the West Point military academy X Poe had problems with respect towards authorities, obeying and following rules excluded again
- married his young cousin Virginia X she died in 1847
- Poe started to suffer from depressions and drink more than ever
- found unconscious in the street, trasported to hospital – he died there 2 years after his wife's death
- only 4 poeple came to his funeral

Poe's literary work

- he lived in poverty became a journalist –
 he wrote articles, short stories and poems for newspapers to earn for his living
- abandoned, misunderstood for many years –
 "discovered" by French symbolists Ch.Baudelaire

SHORT STORIES:

- E.A.Poe = a master of mystery, suspense he plays with his readers, manipulates them to create the strongest possible effect of terror
- he is a founder of modern <u>horror</u> and <u>detective stories</u> – inspired by Gothic novels – set to old gloomy castles, cellars, dark cells
- a motif of madness, mental health a good psychologist

The Pit and the Pendulum

a terrifying story of a victim of the Spanish
 Inquisition – mental torture decribed in detail

The Fall of the House of Usher

- a cursed family of Roderick Usher living in a haunted house
- unknown evil revealed in the end nothing supernatural – the only evil is caused by Roderick himself

The Black Cat

- a motif of mudrer and madness
- = a symbol of justice, punishment



The Mask of the Red Death

- = a symbol of plague
- gloomy atmosphere of a locked castle no escape possible

Murders in the Rue Morgue

a character of detective Dupin = inspiration for Doyle's
 Sherlock Holmes – brilliant, cool logic

POETRY:

The Raven

- = a romantic ballad
- = a symbol of death ultimate, unchangable, eternal
- the loss of a beloved woman and finally a loss of hope constant repetition of the Raven's "Never more"
