## Relative clauses

We use relative clauses to describe people, things, places, certain time, or people's possessions or to give some extra information about them.

We use WHO to talk about people:

e.g. The man WHO is talking to my brother is my class teacher.

We use WHICH for things:

e.g. A lipstick is a thing WHICH women put on their lips.

We use WHERE for places:

e.g. This is the hotel WHERE we stayed during our last holiday.

We use WHEN to talk about time:

e.g. This was the summer WHEN I met my future husband.

And finally, we use WHOSE to describe people's possessions:

e.g. I know a woman WHOSE daughter is a famous model.

**!!! We can also use THAT instead of WHO or WHICH:**

e.g. The man WHO / THAT is talking to my brother is my class teacher.

A lipstick is a thing WHICH / THAT women put on their lips.
